Our speech-language pathologists will analyze writing samples to address the individual strengths and weaknesses of each child in the program.

Write Now is designed for children ages 8-18 and focuses on:

Improving the writing process:

- Planning
- Organizing
- Drafting
- Revising
- Editing

Improving the language skills needed to write:

- Sentences
- Word Choice
- Connecting ideas
- Spelling
- Other writing conventions

Appropriate for children with Speech-Language Delay, Reading Disability, CAPD Learning Disabilities and children who receive Speech Improvement, Reading or Writing Lab, Resource Room services or other students who struggle with the writing process.

The experts at Rochester Hearing and Speech Center will work with your child 2 times a week in a group setting. The program also includes opportunities for parents to learn techniques to use with their child at home.
