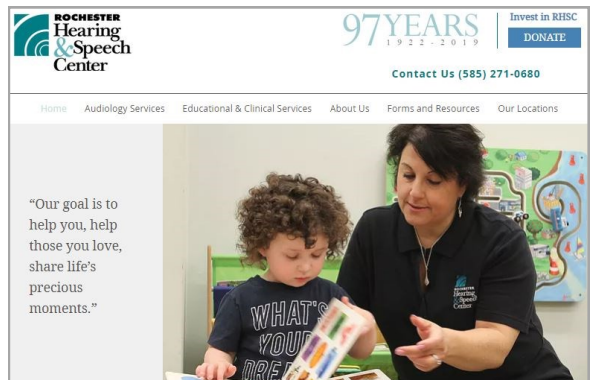


### Our NEW website is here, providing rich insight into our services!

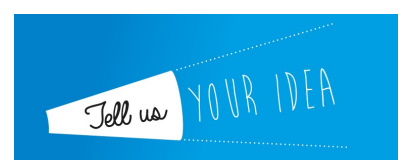

Significance of Snack Time!

#### It's a must – Snack Time!

Snack time for the Early Intervention Developmental Group Program (EI) at Rochester Hearing and Speech Center is an engaging experience that can be used to help children with feeding issues and those with developmental delays. During snack time the children and the food are the focus. If a child does not enjoy being at a meal, including snack times, they're not going to eat. Children coming into contact with different textures, smells, and tastes will help with feeding issues. Not to mention heighten their engagement in various communication techniques, social interactions, and feeding/fine/gross motor skills.



The more children are involved in their snack time routine, the more exposure they will have to various foods and become to enjoy their surroundings. When a routine is set, a child feels safe and secure; they will want to try new foods and focus on the reinforced positive behaviors during snack time.
