



EARLY CHILDHOOD EVALUATIONS

Did you know that if you have concerns about your child's development, you can get an evaluation for free?

If your child is 3-5 years old, just call your school district. Schools are open for in-person sessions. School district staff are helping families get evaluations for their children for speech and language, motor skills, social skills, self-help, and cognitive development.

Rochester Hearing and Speech Center is an approved preschool evaluator. RHSC is also able to provide services if your child qualifies based on evaluation results.

If your child is younger than 3, you can access a free evaluation by contacting your county's Early Intervention program. For your county's referral information, please call the Growing Up Healthy Hotline at (800) 522-5006.

If your child does not qualify for services through the school district or county, but you still have concerns, RHSC offers private pay services in all areas of development.
