NOW OFFERING CURBSIDE HEARING AID REPAIRS AND TELEHEALTH

Even though COVID-19 has necessitated the temporary closure of our buildings, we are still offering emergency curbside hearing aid repairs (incorporating protective safety measures) and TeleHealth services.
